Revitalizing Winter damaged lawns

Snow covered lawns may need extra care.



Most homeowners don't think much about the grass which has been lying dormant under the record snow cover we have had during the Winter of 2011. Our trained turf experts at Conserv-A-Lawn realize

prolonged snow cover can have damaging effects on the underlying turf. This year we are anticipating a possible outbreak of an unsightly fungus called Gray Snow Mold. More commonly a problem in states with typically longer snow cover than our region, this unsightly mold is expected to occur locally this year. The cold, damp conditions under the snow, particularly when thawing, are the perfect environment for fungal development.
